  - Entry to the grounds is at your own risk and the 'Waiver of liability' form must be signed by all entrants prior to participation; this is a condition of our insurance.
  - Nominees are to list all classes you wish to compete in on entry form.
  - The organisers / committee reserve the right to cancel or combine classes if there are insufficient entries.
  - The organisers reserve the right to alter or amend this programme in any way it deems fit without giving prior warning.
  - The organisers **do not** accept responsibility for the loss or damage to horses, harness or vehicles, owners, drivers, passengers, spectators or any other persons or property whilst at or near the venue of this event.
  - Protests must be in writing within 30 minutes of the event ending accompanied by \$100 which must be given to the head of the ground jury. \$100 is not refundable if protest is dismissed. The ground jury's decision is final on all matters.
  - Blinkers - All equines must be wearing blinkers whilst in harness.
  - Drivers 6-7 years are to be accompanied by an adult ACDS member who is a competent driver, holding a second set of reins and sitting next to the junior.
  - Drivers 8-15 years must be accompanied by an adult ACDS member who is a competent driver and sitting next to the junior.
  - A junior driver ages 16-17 years inclusive competing with a single horse or pony may carry a groom or passenger at his/her discretion.
  - A junior driver aged 16-17 years may drive a pair of ponies but not horses or larger combinations.
  - Junior drivers aged 16-17 years may be allowed to drive stallions at ACDS show events at the discretion of the organisers.
  - All junior drivers aged 17 years and under must wear an approved helmet.
  - It is recommended that all competitors have a suitably attired handler available at all times.
  - All equines competing must be 3 years old or over.
  - No classes will be held up so please be ready.
  - Strictly NO DOGS, except assistance dogs.
  - In the event of breakage of equipment (harness or carriage) and you are unable to complete the class as presented, it will be deemed that you have retired and will take no further part in that class and be ineligible for placings.
  - Please leave your area neat and clean of manure, feed and rubbish.
  - Equines are not to be tied to a float which is not hitched to a towing vehicle.
  - Riders under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by a parent or caregiver.
  - Rider's age will be as at the day of the event, proof of age may be requested.
  - Riders any age on ponies unless otherwise stated.

Showground access:	<p>All horse floats must enter through GATE 6 - entrance to this gate off Frederick St Wanneroo. Gates open from 6:30am Saturday November 15th 2025.</p> <p><b>Strictly limited parking available.</b></p> <p>Horse floats must be parked in accordance with the attendant's instructions.</p> <p>No car parking available unless attached to horse float carrying competing horses.</p> <p>One horse = 2 free admittance tickets. Any additional persons will be charged at Show Entry rates or entry will be refused.</p> <p>Any persons disobeying parking instructions will be removed from the showgrounds and no refunds will be issued for events entered.</p>
Prize Money:	<p>Prize money will be paid out <b>after 3:00pm</b> on the Saturday of the Show and can be collected from the prize counter outside the Margaret Cockman Pavillion (if unsure, please visit horse events caravan). The Harness competition comprises horses and ponies which are divided into Carriage Driving, Race Cart and Working Harness competitions. Horses are judged on conformation, presentation, manners, and paces within their field. Carriage driving is the discipline of horses working with either two or four wheeled carriages presenting an elegant spectacle. Heavy Harness horses are presented in harnesses without vehicles simulating the traditional work draft horses were bred to do. Race cart competitions showcase the Standardbred racehorse in their post-racing careers as show horses
