Points: First Prize, 5.

Conditions (general):

All exhibits to be the property of and grown by the Exhibitor (except classes Floral Art and Endemic Plant Arrangement classes).
Should only one exhibit be received for any one class, no prize will be awarded unless in the opinion of the judges such an exhibit would have obtained a prize had there been competition.
Pot plants to be displayed in one container only and all pots to be cleaned and free from slugs, insects, etc.
Distinct means different species.
Pot plants, indoor plants and hanging baskets must not exceed 30cm in diameter, unless otherwise specified.
Judges may award Highly Commended certificates where appropriate.

Conditions (Floral art and endemic arrangements):

Floral arrangements to be the original work of the exhibitor and not a recognisable copy from another person, book or magazine.
Exhibitor must stage their own work.
Plant material must predominate over all the components of the design, no artificial plant material permitted.
ONE (1) entry per exhibitor, per class only.
Space allowed is 60cm (width) x 75cm (depth).

Collection of exhibits: 8-10am Sunday 16th November 2025 at the Margaret Cockman Pavillion.
